- » **Points of General Interest concerning Regulatory Aspects:** Mr Corrie Nel, Legal Representative, Fedfood

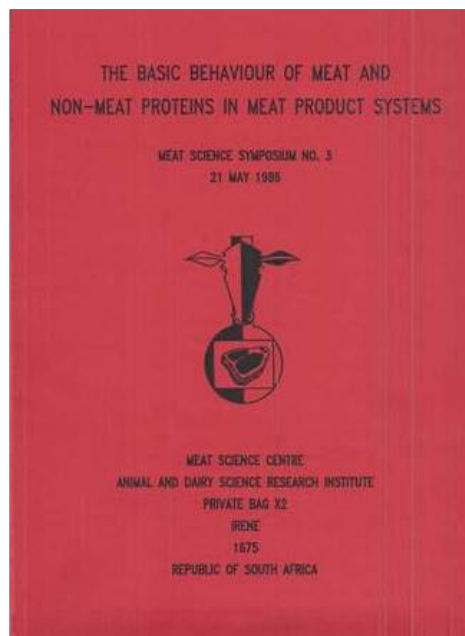
